

The Act2 Project team is excited to announce the release of its latest re-

port, Act2: In Response to God's Call.

It emerges from one of the biggest direct consultation processes the Assembly has ever undertaken, during which the Act2 team has contacted almost every Uniting Church community and personally visited every state and territory to sit down and learn from people across the Uniting Church.

In the words of Jesuit theologian Walter Burghardt, the report is a "long, loving look at the real" of our Church at this time, offered in love and hope, and drawing from a deep well of insight gathered over the last six months.

The report is now available to <u>read in full</u>. It brings together a summary of what the team has heard, theological reflections and a set of directions and options for the future, which the Church is now invited to consider together.
